

### PREFECT ROLE SPECIFICATIONS

Westlake Girls High School Prefects hold a very important position in the school and in our wider school community. They are primarily responsible for upholding and enhancing the high standards and culture of Westlake Girls as a leading girls' school with a national and international reputation.

As significant role models, all Prefects must demonstrate the high standards and values of Westlake Girls every day, in and out of the School.

## All School Prefects are expected to:

- Be positive, set high standards, exercise good judgment and adhere to school rules
- Demonstrate high standards of uniform and attendance, punctuality, and a sound academic focus
- Be a good ambassador for the school
- Be cooperative, helpful, trustworthy and responsible
- Be respectful toward teachers, peers and the school environment
- Assist with school assemblies and events e.g. Open Evening, Parent Evenings, Career & Guidance Evenings and Presentation Evenings
- Motivate and encourage students to participate in School and House events throughout the year
- Show initiative and be able to work independently and as part of a team, in order to generate new ideas and develop them
- Willingly assist with the smooth running of the school during the school day by regularly and reliably performing duties
- Be involved with all aspects of school life, both within the school day and outside school hours, including extracurricular activities, House assemblies and events

### **Head Prefect**

- Be exemplary in all duties as a role model and ambassador, promoting the ethos of the school
- Lead the Prefect Team
- Liaise with the Principal and Senior Leadership Team
- Attend weekly Prefect Executive meetings with the Principal
- Represent Westlake Girls High School at events inside and outside School
- Promote and support House and School events

## **Deputy Head Prefect**

- Act as a positive role model and promote the ethos of the school
- Assist in leading the Prefect Team
- Liaise with the school's Senior Leadership Team
- Attend weekly Prefect Executive meetings with the Principal
- Represent Westlake Girls High School at events inside and outside School
- Promote and support school events

### **House Captain**

- Lead the House Prefect Team
- Lead assembly or coordinate its leadership using other Prefects
- Represent your House at School events
- Attend weekly Prefect Executive meetings with the Principal

### **Academic Prefect**

- Promote academic excellence
- Promote the importance of focus, effort and aiming for excellence academically
- Develop and promote academic support programmes to assist students to achieve their academic potential
- Organise and promote House events with an academic theme e.g. Mastermind, Spelling Bee
- Inform students of academic successes at the weekly House assembly

### **Arts Prefect**

- Promote creative excellence
- Promote student involvement in Creative Arts activities: Talent shows, Theatresports, Art exhibitions, Debating etc.
- Encourage students to participate in extracurricular activities: choirs, orchestras, drama groups, school productions etc.
- Acknowledge students' successes at assembly

### **Cultural Prefect**

- Promote and embrace cultural diversity and global citizenship
- Assist with cultural events: Cultural week, Chinese and Korean nights
- Organise and run mixed cultural night (during Cultural Week) for Indian, Polynesian,
  Maori, Japanese and other nationalities
- Work with the International Department and International Student Prefects to assist with the integration of international students into the school
- Promote and assist with organisation of events for 40 Hour Famine

### **Environmental Prefect**

- Promote and develop sustainable practices, liaising when required with the Envirogroup
- Promote a clean, litter-free school environment, with special responsibility for recycling
- Liaise with Junior School Prefects to promote sustainability practices to juniors
- Assist with events: Earth Hour, Trash to Fashion, beach clean-up, community tree-planting
- Promote bio-diversity and the protection of vulnerable species in NZ

### **International Student Prefect**

- Assist with all new International students to integrate successfully in WGHS
- Be a link with other senior prefects so the International Students can participate in everything the school offers
- Run/assist with the International Assembly
- Organise activities each term for International Students
- Organise Festivals and Celebrations for International students and assist with orientation

### **Service Prefect**

- Promote service to others
- Help with all fundraising opportunities
- Encourage students to support the House charity, by participating in House related events
- Organise school events to promote and support the House charity
- Assist in the organisation of schoolwide service events: Daffodil day, Anzac day etc.
- Build an awareness of community engagement and the benefits of giving back to the community
- Volunteering time

# **Sport and Wellbeing Prefect**

- Promote nutrition, health, wellbeing and physical activity
- Encourage students to participate in sporting activities offered at school
- Assist in the advertising and organisation of sports events
- Organise sporting House events that instil school spirit and culture
- Inform students of sporting successes at the weekly assembly
- Attend a number of sporting fixtures and support the teams
- Assist in the organisation of the Sporting Excellence Award Evening

## **Junior School Prefect**

- Assist Year 9 students to integrate successfully into Westlake Girls High School
- Encourage and support junior students to get fully involved in school life
- Work closely with one Year 9 form class
- Promote the Citizenship Award in Year 9 and encourage students to participate
- Organise and implement a programme for Year 9 students which embraces Key Competencies, study skills etc.
